



Fellowship for Iranian students Workshop on "METHODS IN ARCHAEOLOGY"

Archaïos and the Louvre Museum, announce a two-week fellowship on "Methods in Archaeology" for Iranian students in winter 2024.

The fellowship consists of a series of intensive courses during two weeks on different methods in archaeology. The aim is to introduce and prepare students for the interdisciplinary work required for archaeological research. They will be trained in both by theoretical and practical aspects.

Courses will cover an introduction to the most recent technologies and tools required for archaeological studies, such as Remote sensing, Geographic Information Systems (GIS), Databases (DB) and Photogrammetry (3D modeling). Additionally, there will be an introduction to various specialties in archaeology such as Ceramology, Lithic Analysis, Archaeometallurgy, Archaeozoology and Archaeobotany. Participants will also visit the Louvre Museum, the Museum of National Archaeology and the Center for Research and Restauration of French Museums (C2RMF).

The fellowship will cover:

- Visa and Travel costs
- Hotel
- Food, Metro and Museum tickets

The fellowship is open to **Bachelor's**, **Master's** and **PhD students**. The classes will be accompanied by a direct translation into Persian.

The deadline for submission is 1st September 2024. Successful applicants will be notified by the end of September 2024.

Courses will be held in Paris from **25th November to 8th December 2024**. An internship report is required at the end of the stay.
