How to apply for the HEC Imagine Fellowship?

The HEC Imagine Fellows program is a scholarship initiative established in 2021 by HEC Paris, dedicated to students from war-torn countries or students proving to be victims of difficult political or geopolitical situations such as refugees, persecuted minorities, political opponents.

Selected students, known for their excellence and academic profiles, receive scholarships to fund their studies at HEC Paris.

The first students were welcomed in September 2022: 3 Afghan women, 1 Syrian and 1 Ukrainian.

In 2024, 13 Fellows are part of the program and 2 Fellows have graduated.

In the perspective of developing the “HEC Imagine Fellows” program (which aims to reach about ten students per year), HEC Paris is looking to identify new Fellows. These will be selected based on their academic excellence as well as their personal interest in intercultural understanding and their commitment to peace.

As promoters of the “Business & Peace” theme, they are ambassadors of the program on the HEC Paris campus. In this capacity, they undertake concrete actions such as creating associations or organizing conferences and events on the theme of peace.

What are the prerequisites for applying to the HEC Imagine Fellows scholarship?

- Hold at least a Bachelor’s degree of at least 3 years with 180 ECTS (European Credits Transfer System) from various fields of study (engineering, humanities and social sciences, data sciences, etc.). Candidates can apply in the year they obtain their original degree.
- Demonstrate academic excellence.
- Proficiency in French is not a criterion for admission (except for Law and International Management, Media, Arts, Creations).
- Excellent command of English is necessary (C1 level of the European Framework of Reference for Languages).
- Candidates are exempt from Management tests (GMAT, GRE, TAGE MAGE).

Application steps:

1. Submission of the application
2. Eligibility results
3. Interview (entirely in English)
4. Admission results

How to check your eligibility with the recruitment service?

Candidates can submit their CV via this [FORM](#) and a member of the recruitment team will contact them after verifying their eligibility for the programs and the Imagine Fellowship. They will also receive detailed information on the application procedure.

How to apply for the HEC Imagine Fellows scholarship?

Candidates can choose to apply in one of the 3 admission sessions scheduled from January to June.

3. Write a 350-word argument answering the following questions and send it in PDF format to <mailto:info-masters@hec.fr> before the publication date of the eligibility results:
 - What makes you a Business & Peace ambassador?
 - What initiatives would you implement on the HEC Paris campus in connection with the Business & Peace issues?

The publication of scholarship award results is announced by email the week following the publication of the admission results.
